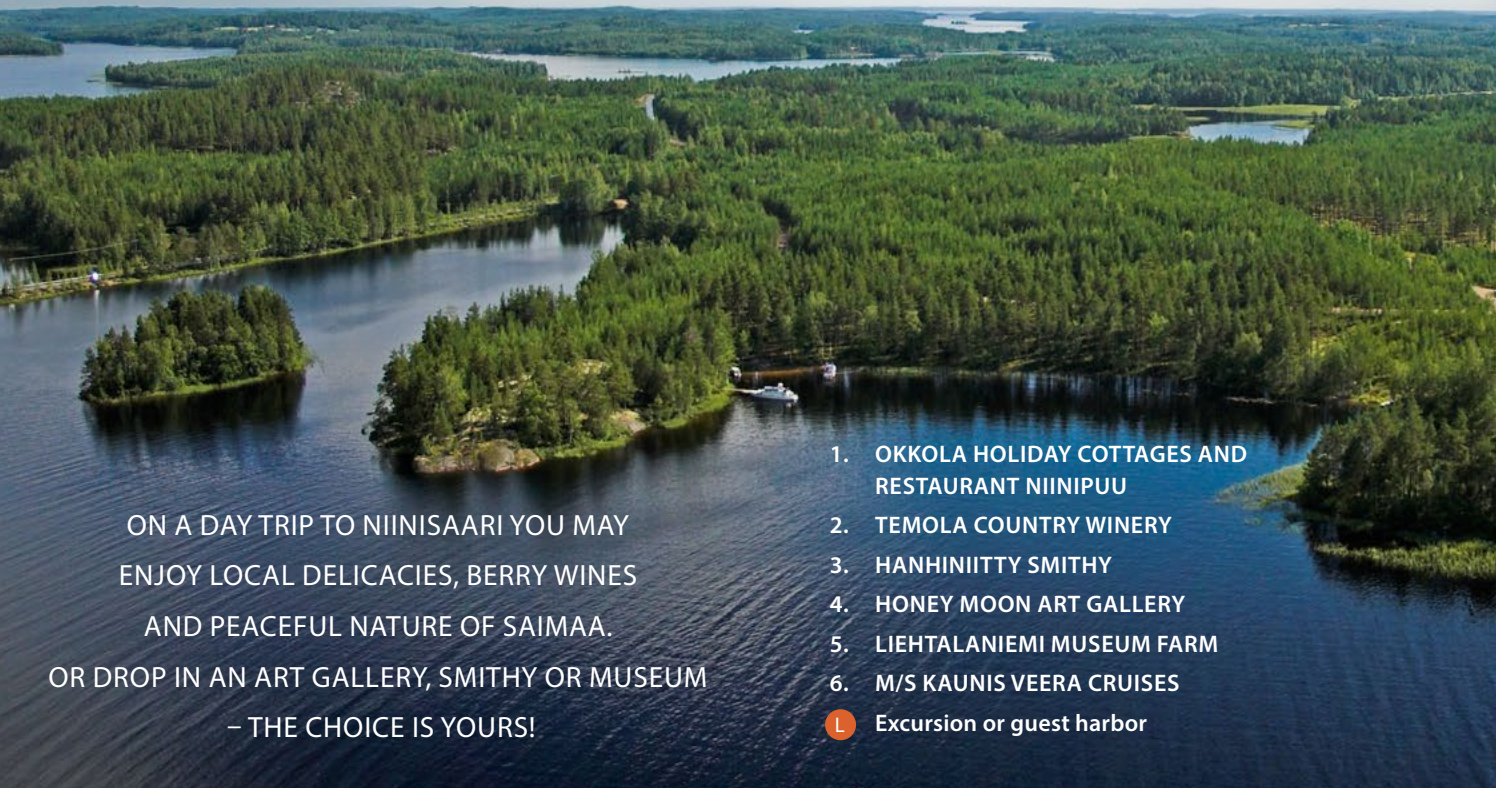
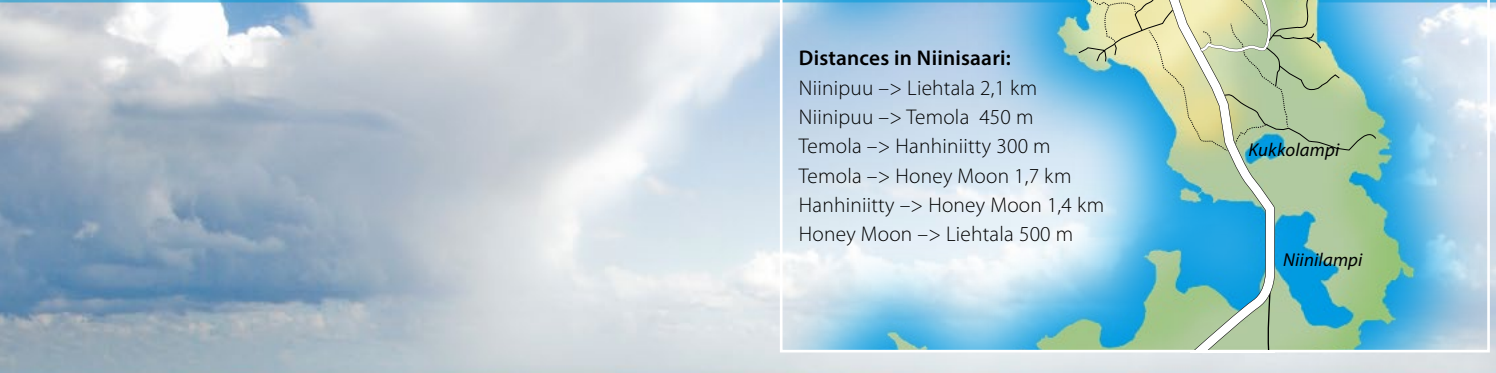
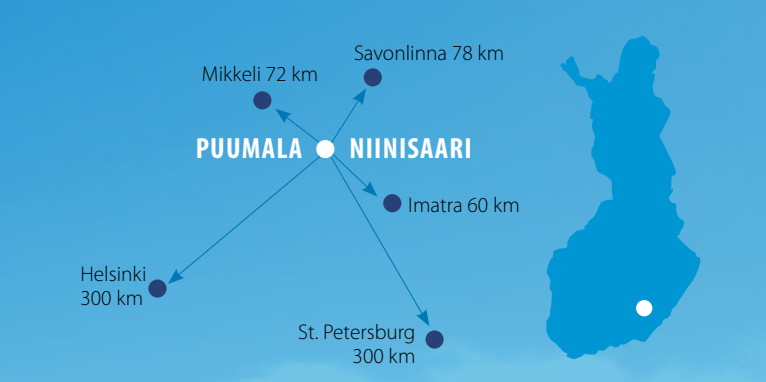

LIEHTALANIEMI MUSEUM FARM

Switch off your mobile phone, sit back and relax. Or listen to the guide telling stories about Jallu (1902–1976), the last and somewhat eccentric tenant of the farm. The estate is now a nature reserve (22 hectares) with a nature trail and a guest harbor for both boaters and paddlers. The museum buildings go back to 19th and 20th centuries. RESTAURANT NIINIPUU

Niinisaari is also a gourmet destination. Built in a stone cow-house in the Okkola farm yard, Restaurant Niinipuu serves local food. Depending on the season and the catch, the menu includes fresh vendace from Lake Saimaa or golden chanterelles carefully picked by the host himself. Our specialties are plank salmon and blueberry rye pie. In summer we serve a generous Sunday buffet at Niinipuu attic. The restaurant is also reachable by boat.
